Sexual Violence

Workshop Outline

This workshop will equip participants with knowledge of the use of sexual violence as a weapon of war and its many effects on survivors. Skills and approaches for working with survivors will be explored and discussed.

Aims

- To raise awareness about the extent and impact of conflict related sexual violence .
- To provide culturally sensitive support for survivors who have experienced conflict related sexual violence .



Performance Criteria

On completion of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- Understand the common impacts on survivors and their families.
- Identify how to sensitively inquire about sexual violence history and respond appropriately to disclosure.
- Have knowledge of appropriate therapeutic models.
- Provide assistance to survivors with greater sensitivity and cultural competency.

FOR: Anyone working with survivors of torture and trauma who may have survived sexual violence in the context of war/oppression.
